TRAINING SCOPE

Pakistan is the 3rd largest goat keeping country in the world. The meat of small ruminants especially from the goats is one of the most expensive in the local souks. Pakistan ranked 3rd in goat meat exporting country and is predicted as one of highly potential country in Halal meat trade. Most of the goats are kept by the nomads and landless farmers which make sector; the poor and fragmented. They keep these animals as scavenger. These small farmers are unable to get maximum profit due to; (i) limited outreach of public sector initiatives to distantly located farmers, (ii) sustainability issues with projects undertaken in the public sector, (iii) conventional methods of raising animals & poor farm management, and (iv) limited awareness of productivity, hygiene and breeding practices in the farmers' community. Training and awareness of stake holders through workshop on commercial mutton production is a prime effort to cater the challenges being faced to farmers. This workshop will serve to build strong linkage between academia and industry addressing key issues to be solved.
